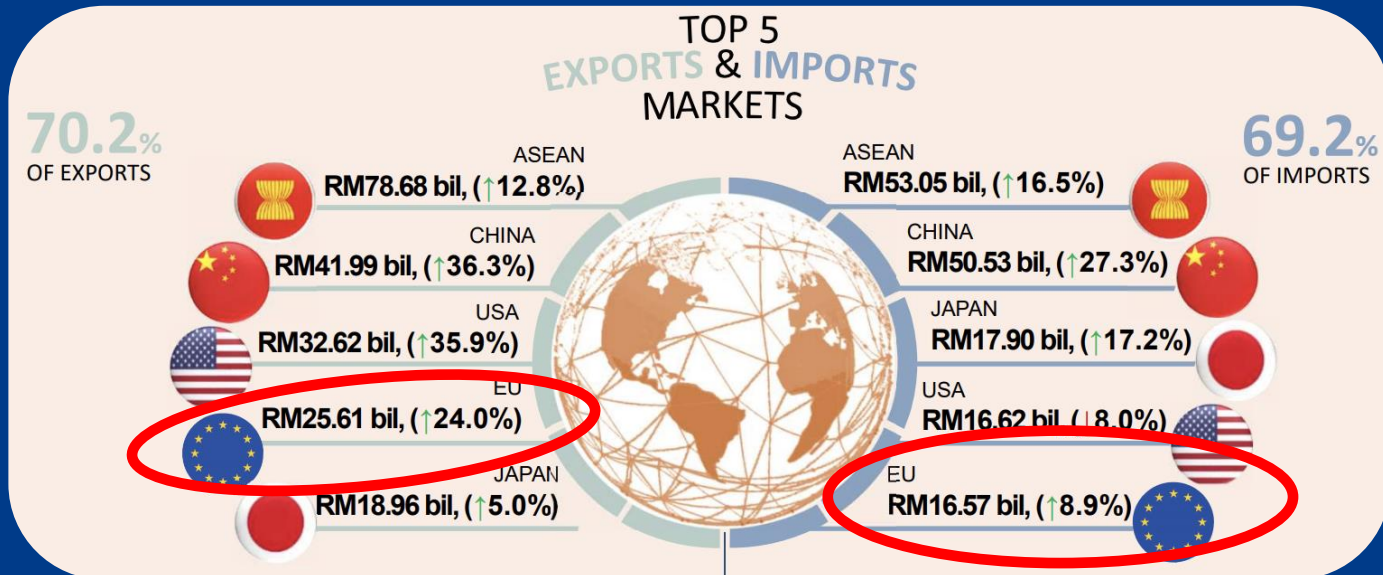

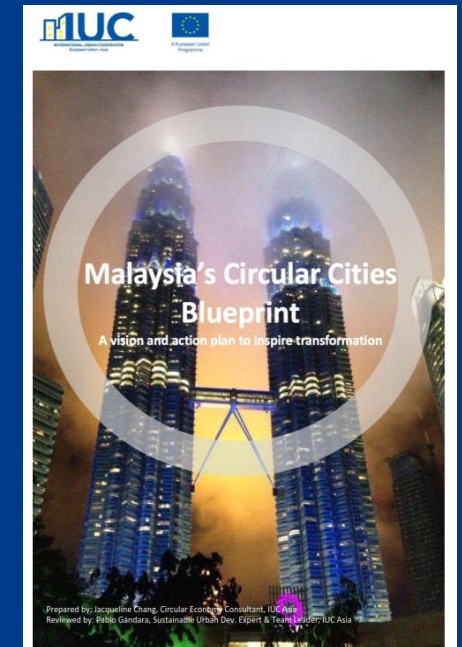
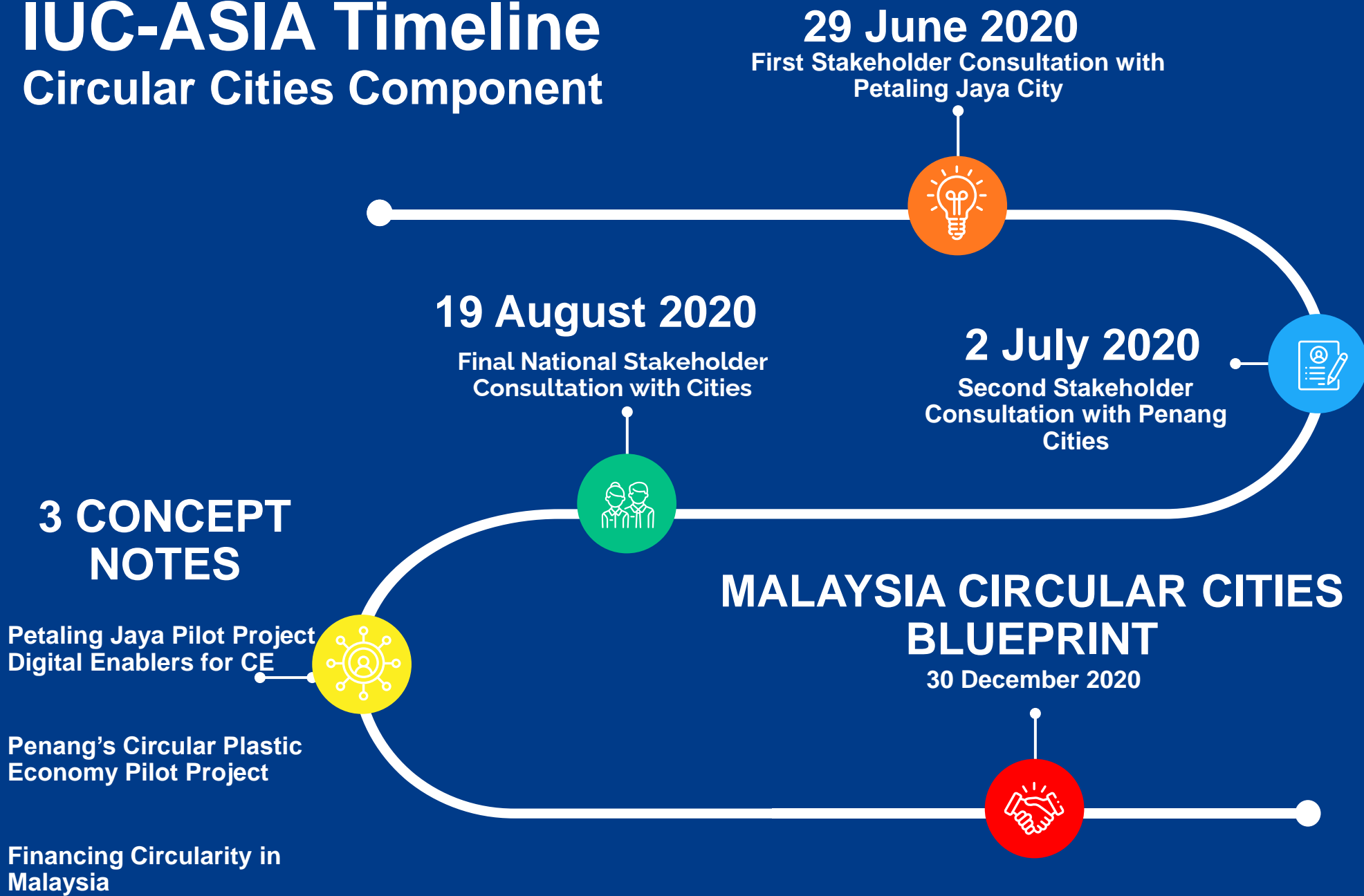
In 2019, trade between Malaysia and the EU totalled RM174.65 (€34.93) billion or 9.5% share of Malaysia’s trade (MATRADE, 2020).

In Q1 2021 (pandemic) exports & imports to major markets namely ASEAN, China, the United States (US) and the European Union (EU) registered a new all-time high as well (MATRADE, 2021).

Previous EU-Malaysia City Cooperation

Malaysia's participation in the IUC-Asia programme involved eight cities in total, namely Kuala Lumpur, Iskandar, Petaling Jaya, Melaka, Penampang, Tawau, Hang Tuah Jaya, Putrajaya and Georgetown.
